

ACCESSIBILITY DECLARATION

The University of Lodz undertakes to ensure the accessibility of its website in accordance with the provisions of the Act of 4 April 2019 on the digital accessibility of websites and mobile applications of public entities.

The accessibility declaration applies to the website **www.llrn6poland.uni.lodz.pl**

Status in terms of compliance with the Act

The website is partially compliant with the Act of 4 April 2019 on digital accessibility of websites and mobile applications of public entities due to the incompatibilities or exclusions listed below.

Inaccessible content

Due to system limitations on the website and the fact that some content comes from different sources:

- not all non-text content on the service has alternative text,
- elements related to contrast and content zooming are omitted in the reader's path,
- at higher page magnification and in the mobile version of the site, there is no phrase search available,
- there may be elements where underlining in links is missing,
- there are situations where the required minimum level of contrast is not met,
- keyboard accessibility is impaired, there is no possibility to undo from the keyboard,
- there is a lack of a clearly visible focus on some elements of the page,
- focus omits elements related to adjusting the size of the text on the page and selecting the type of contrast,
- no information on transferring to external web pages or downloading files to the computer,
- alternative page navigation is missing,
- there are situations where the lang tag is incorrectly applied,
- the purpose of a link is not always adequately specified
- structural errors may be encountered in the code,
- the order and hierarchy of headings may be disrupted.

The site editors make every effort to ensure that digitally inaccessible content, where possible, is corrected and made digitally accessible to the widest possible audience on the site.

Everyone has the right to:

- make comments on the accessibility of a digital site or an element of it,
- to request that a digital site or element thereof be made accessible,
- request that the inaccessible information be made available in another alternative form.

The request must include:

- the contact details of the person making the request,
- an indication of the page or element of the page to which the request relates,
- an indication of the convenient form in which the information can be made available if the request is for the non-accessible information to be made available in an alternative form.
- The request should be dealt with promptly, at the latest within 7 days. If it is not possible to provide accessibility or provide access in an alternative form within this period, it should take place at the latest within 2 months of the date of notification.

Complaints and appeals

If the deadlines are not met or the request to provide accessibility or alternative access to information is refused, a complaint may be lodged with the supervisory authority by post or email:
